### About the symposium

On 13 May a symposium will be organized by the former partners of the INTUIT-project ([www.intuitproject.nl](http://www.intuitproject.nl)) and affiliated projects. The topic of INTUIT - English language teaching in Higher Education, based on the CEF and supported by ICT - will be revisited.

We are pleased to present as key note speakers Prof. Dr. Lut Baten (Katholieke Universiteit Leuven) and Prof. Dr. Jan Van Maele (GROUP T-Leuven Engineering College and Katholieke Universiteit Leuven) who will present how they integrate the CEF in everyday teaching and how they make use of technology in that context.

The other presentations will be by colleagues who will talk about how they have continued to use and extend the tools and practices developed during the INTUIT and NAP-projects. This will include discussions of new ways in which the Language Tool Box, one of the main results of the INTUIT-project, has been used and new areas of study to which it has been applied.

The symposium will end with a discussion of how the teachers, language centres and others involved in providing English language teaching can continue to work together and exchange expertise and experiences in the area of ICT-enhanced English language teaching in Higher Education. We will also consider the role that the NUT Academic English SIG might play in this process.
